<b>Cambridge Prognostic Group (CPG)</b>	<b>Criteria</b>	<b>Treatment recommendation</b>
<b>1</b>	Gleason 6 (grade group 1) <b>and</b> prostate specific antigen (PSA) < 10 µg/L <b>and</b> stages T1-T2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Offer active surveillance</li><li>● Consider radical prostatectomy or radical radiotherapy if active surveillance is not suitable or acceptable to the person</li></ul>
<b>2</b>	Gleason score 3 + 4 = 7 (grade group 2) <b>or</b> PSA 10-20 µg/L <b>and</b> stages T1-T2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Offer a choice between active surveillance, radical prostatectomy or radiotherapy if radical treatment is suitable</li></ul>
<b>3</b>	Gleason score 3 + 4 = 7 (grade group 2) <b>and</b> PSA 10-20 µg/L <b>and</b> stages T1-T2 <b>Or</b> Gleason 4 + 3 = 7 (grade group 3) and stages T1-T2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Offer radical prostatectomy or radical radiotherapy</li><li>● Consider active surveillance for people who choose not to have immediate radical treatment</li></ul>
<b>4</b>	One of: Gleason score 8 (grade group 4), PSA > 20 µg/L, stage T3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Offer radical prostatectomy or radical radiotherapy when it is likely that the prostate cancer can be controlled in the long term</li><li>● Do not offer active surveillance</li></ul>
<b>5</b>	Two or more of: Gleason score 8 (grade group 4), PSA > 20 µg/L, stage T3 <b>Or</b> Gleason score 9 to 10 (grade group 5) <b>Or</b> stage T4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Offer radical prostatectomy or radical radiotherapy when it is likely that the prostate cancer can be controlled in the long term</li><li>● Do not offer active surveillance</li></ul>
